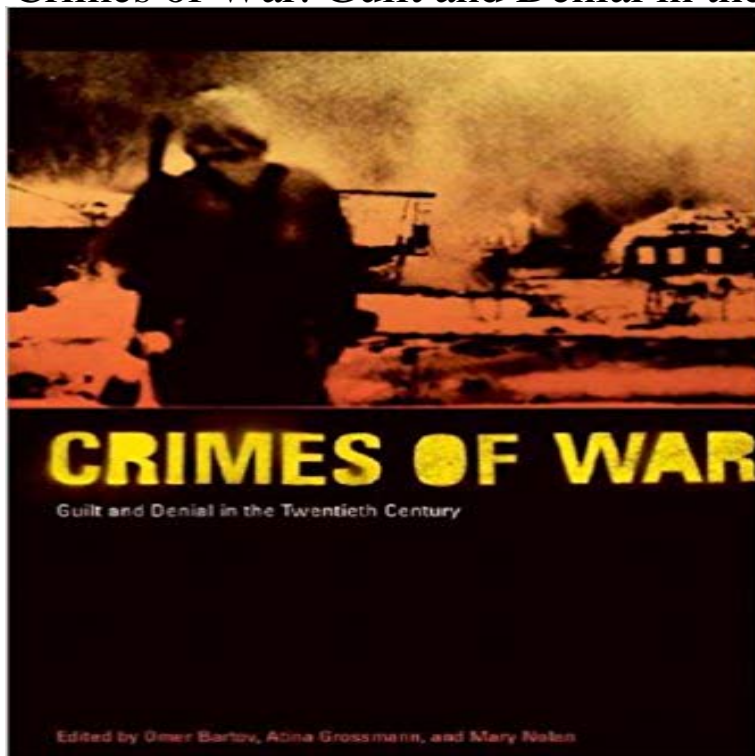


Crimes of War: Guilt and Denial in the Twentieth Century

Emerging from these accounts is a distinctive, repeated pattern, which typically includes a half-century of denial before the truth is confronted.
