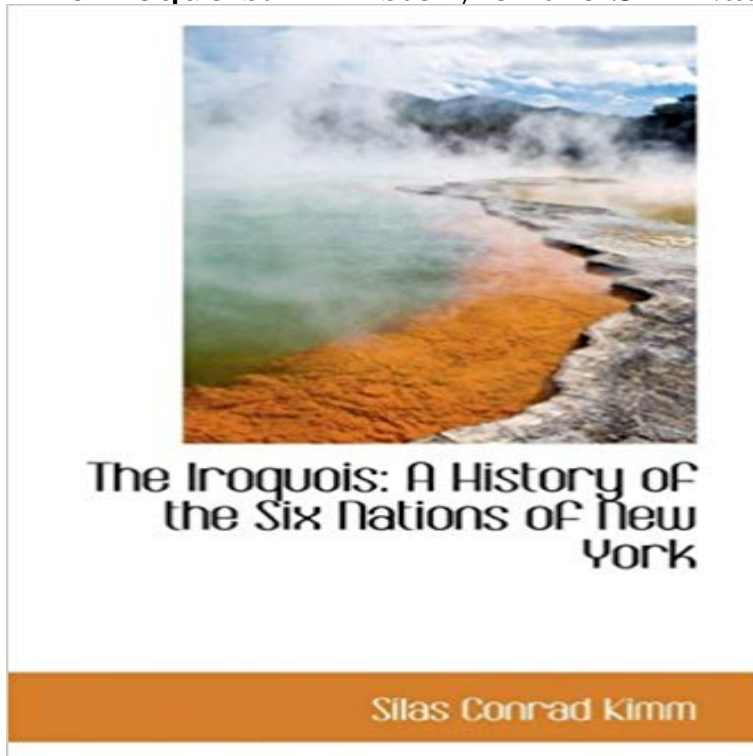


# The Iroquois: A History of the Six Nations of New York
