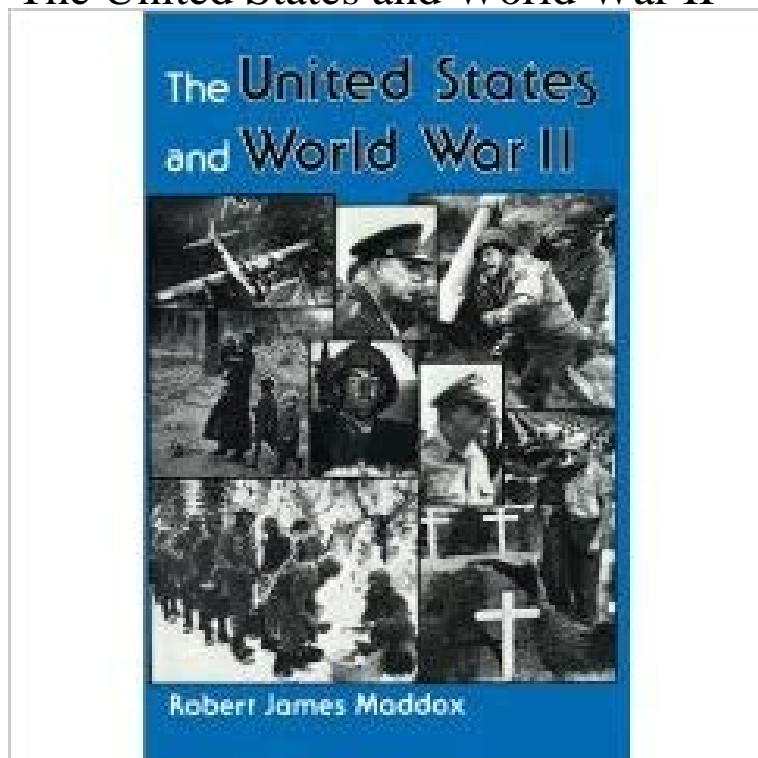


The United States and World War II
