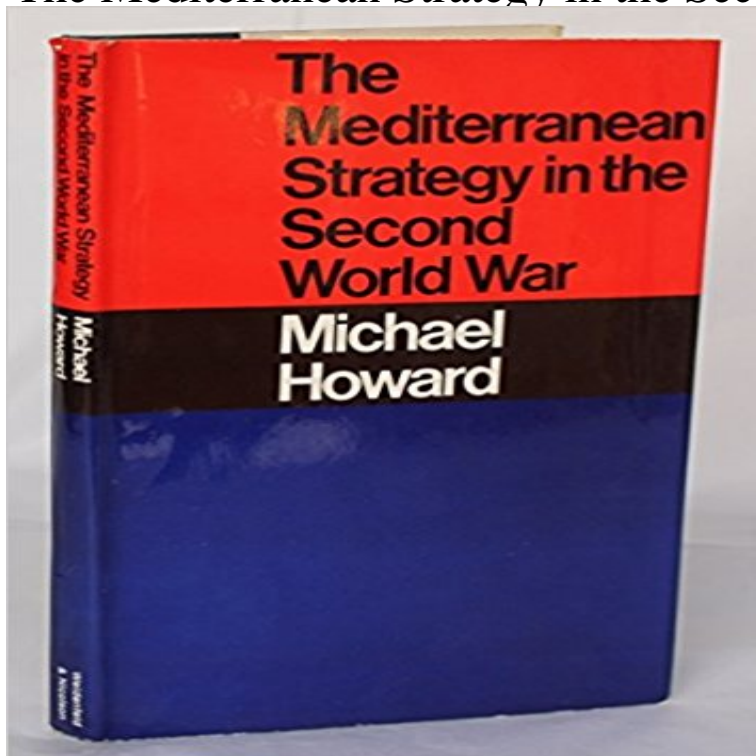


The Mediterranean Strategy in the Second World War



In this lucid study, Professor Howard finally disposes of certain misconceptions about Allied strategy in the second world war. In the debate about Allied strategy which raged in the nineteen-fifties it was widely held that British leaders had advocated invasion of the Balkans, that the failure of the Allies to adopt this strategy allowed the Soviet Union to occupy eastern Europe, and this in turn was responsible for many of the international problems of the post-war world. This view of the British position cannot be sustained on the basis of evidence which has subsequently appeared. Professor Howard's analysis shows what the Mediterranean strategy actually was, its origins and development, and also what its authors hoped to achieve by it. The question of whether the strategy employed by the Allies was right or wrong, Professor Howard wisely refrains from asking: this he leaves to intrigue the reader.
