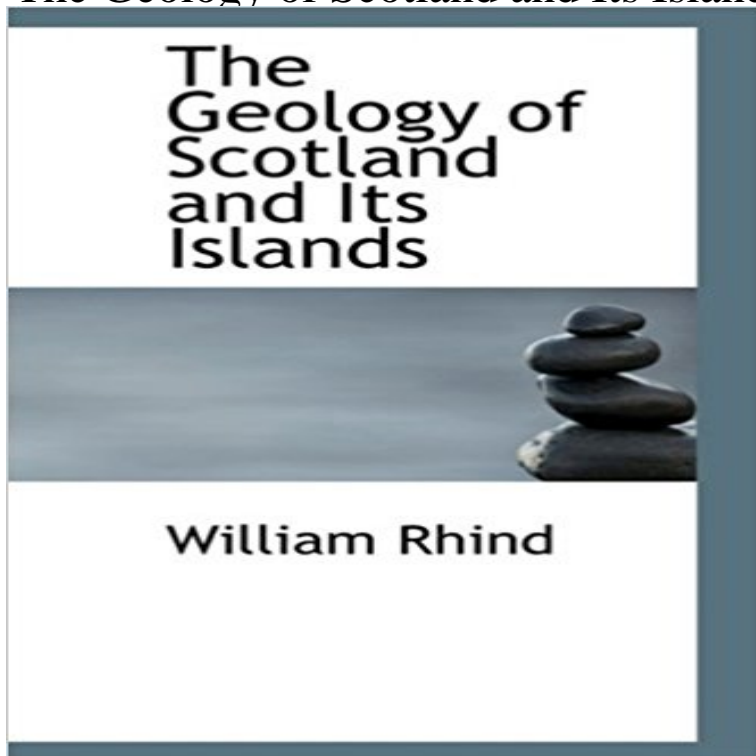


The Geology of Scotland and Its Islands
