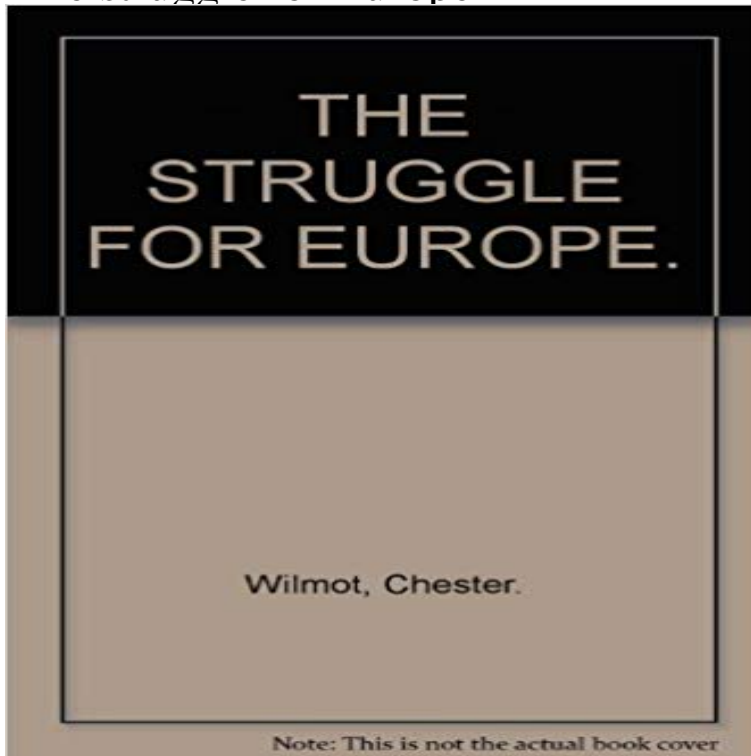


The struggle for Europe
