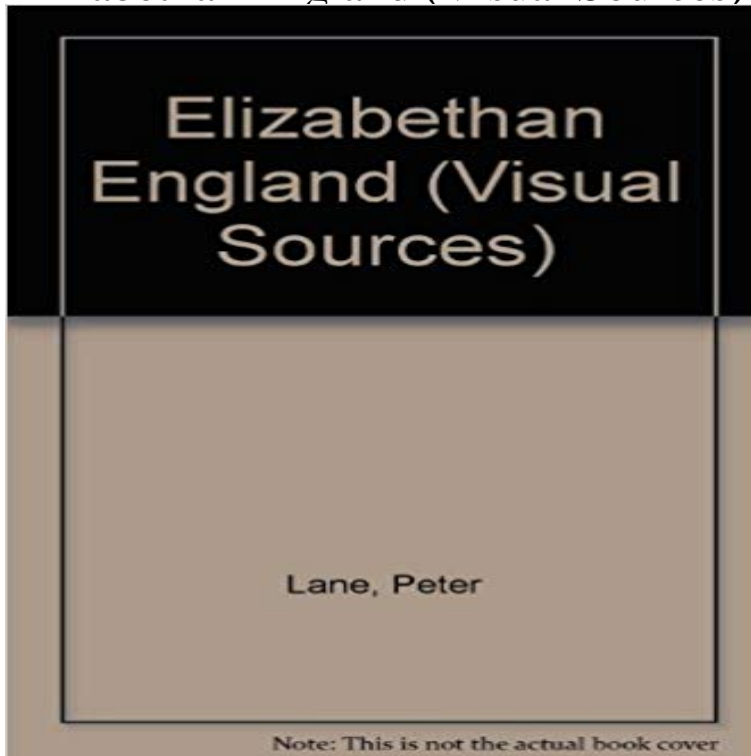


Elizabethan England (Visual Sources)
